2012-2013 Senior Survey results

Summary for Virginia Tech

Prepared by The Office of Academic Assessment June 2013

Undergraduate students intending to graduate in December 2012, May 2013 or summer 2013, as identified by their departments, were asked to complete a web-based survey soliciting their opinions regarding aspects of their experience at Virginia Tech. After an initial contact, a follow-up from a departmental representative, and another follow-up from the Office of Academic Assessment, 1852 students across the University returned completed surveys, resulting in a response rate of 43.9%. As you review the attached information, please note the quality of these data depend on the number of students responding, the response rate for your area, and the particular wording of each question. The survey provides only an overview of student perceptions and does not allow for in-depth analysis that would lead to explanations behind those perceptions.
